
AUDITIONS AND ADMISSIONS:

Vocal Auditions:

The successful vocal audition will consist of:

- 1. Performance of a series of unrehearsed musical assignments provided on site, and
- Performance of a musical selection not to exceed two minutes from the following categories: Sacred/Gospel, Classical, Patriotic, or Musical Theatre. Applicants may perform a cappella or provide their own accompaniment. A piano will be available for your audition. Recorded accompaniment with no background vocals may be used, a CD/ tape player will be provided.
- 3. Personal Interview

Dance Auditions:

The successful dance audition will consist of:

- 1. Prepared dance piece of no more than two minutes
- 2. Personal interview

Acting Auditions:

The successful dramatic arts audition will consist of:

- 1. Performance of a cold read, and
- 2. Performance of a memorized dramatic or comedic monologue (words spoken by one person in a play) from a published play (2 minute maximum). Use no costumes.
